

#### Call to Order and Roll Call

The City Council Special Called Virtual Meeting was called to order at 3:04 pm by Mayor Shameka S. Reynolds. A roll call was taken, and the following City Council Members were present: Darold Honore, Amelia Inman, Vanneriah Wynn, and Ric Dodd. Diane Howard was absent.

### III. Discussion

## a. Approval to Re-Finance

Councilman Honore motioned for discussion to approve the BB&T Agreement for Option 1 or Option 2; the motion was seconded by Councilman Dodd.

Councilman Honore withdrew his motion and motioned to enter into agreement with BB&T for refinancing, Option 1 payment agreement, the motion was seconded by Councilman Dodd; and approved by a vote of 4-0.

### b. **Annexation**

Councilman Dodd stated that he met with the committee and made plans to pass out a flyer or doorhanger on March 13 and March 20. Asking for council to provide ideas via email or text on what to place on the flyers. Mayor Reynolds suggested using the city's graphic designer to compose the flyer. State Representative Doreen Carter is working with the state on finalizing the boundaries, and the advertisement needs to be reposted.

### c. Film Application

Darius Evans the Unit Production Manager for Merry Switchmas LLC stated that his production company is shooting a "g-rated" feature children's film called Merry Switchmas; one-day inside shoot at 6981 Main Street, crew of 37 people and 5 cast members, 1-2 hour exterior shoot on the sidewalk. No street closure is required and working with Wayfield's as their base camp. COVID Protocol Filming Standards: all actors, cast and crew are COVID tested 3 x's week, a cleaning crew sanitizes the location prior to and after filming, social distancing and PPE is provided for everyone on set. Police coverage is not required.

Councilwoman Inman motioned to approve the film application for A Merry Switchmas on Sunday February 21, 2021, the motion was seconded by Councilwoman Wynn, and approved by a vote of 4-0.
