The election season is underway. The deadline to register to vote in the primary is **April 25**. The primary is **May 24**, with any runoff on **June 21**.



To register, you must be at least 18 on Election Day, a U.S. citizen, and a legal resident of your county. Check your registration, obtain applications, view sample ballots, and locate your polling place at MVP.SOS.GA.gov.

New Health Care Special Enrollment Period Opportunity For Low-income Consumers At Or Below 150% Of The Federal Poverty Level

The Biden-Harris Administration is announcing a new Special Enrollment Period (SEP) opportunity for low-income consumers at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL), which is approximately \$19,000 for an individual and \$40,000 for a family of four. This SEP will be available to consumers who have applied for Marketplace coverage since Open Enrollment ended and who didn't have access to another SEP from a recent life event, such as a loss of coverage, and will enable eligible consumers to enroll in a Marketplace plan. Navigators, assisters, agents, and brokers are helping get the word out about the SEP to their communities and assisting those who qualify in signing up for affordable health care coverage.

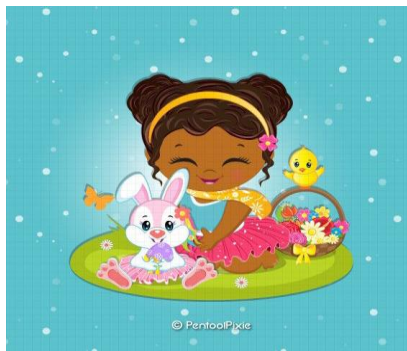
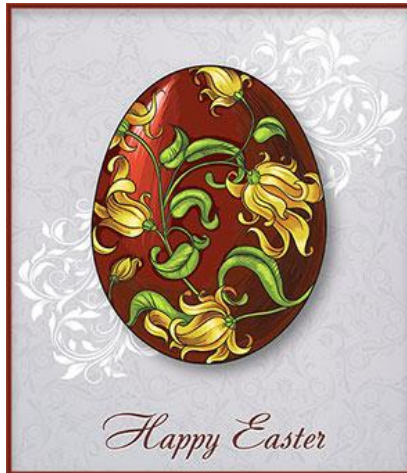
- Consumers who think they may qualify for this SEP should visit [HealthCare.gov](https://www.healthcare.gov) or [CuidadoDeSalud.gov](https://www.cuidadodesalud.gov) to view 2022 plans and prices and enroll in a plan that best meets their needs. Additionally, consumers can call the [Marketplace Call Center](https://www.marketplace.gov) at 1-800-318-2596, which provides assistance in over 150 languages. TTY users should call 1-855-889-4325. Consumers can also find a local assister or agent/broker in their area: <https://localhelp.healthcare.gov>.
- Consumers residing in states with Marketplaces that operate their own platforms should check with their state Marketplaces regarding whether they are offering this SEP and any actions consumers may need to take.
