To register, you must be at least 18 on Election Day, a U.S. citizen, and a legal resident of your county. Check your registration, obtain applications, view sample ballots, and locate your polling place at <u>MVP.SOS.GA.gov</u>.

This session is part of a monthslong effort to solicit community feedback and shape a conceptual design that will guide future activation and preservation of the historic <u>Bruce Street School</u>. The design process will wrap up in June.

This project is a collaboration between the City of Lithonia, DeKalb County, and the Arabia Mountain Heritage Area Alliance. SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES May 15, 2022 Deadline

The Greater Lithonia Chamber of Commerce will select 5 graduating seniors to receive a scholarship.
