

## **CITY OF LITHONIA MINUTES**-PUBLIC HEARING ON FY20 MILLAGE RATE VIRTUAL MEETING Monday, July 6, 2020 @ 11:30 AM

## I. Call to Order and Roll Call

The City Council Public Hearing on the FY20 Millage Rate Virtual Meeting was called to order at 11:41 am by Mayor Shameka S. Reynolds. A roll call was taken and the following City Council Members were present: Amelia Inman, and Ric Dodd. Diane Howard, Darold Honore, and Vanerriah Wynn were absent.

## II. Consideration of 2020 Millage Rate

City Administrator Lathaydra Sands worked closely with DeKalb County on the rollback rate, proposing to accept 11.081 as the millage rate, with a 0% increase.

State Representative Doreen Carter, resident of City of Lithonia commented that when looking at the digest, Lithonia's value has increased almost \$20ML, her question is that she would like to know how the \$421,000 is allocated in the budget, and if the \$421,000 is actually needed with a significant increase within the past 5-years. Ms. Carter is requesting to see a copy of the FY20 budget.

There were no questions or comments from Council.
