I. Call to Order and Roll Call

III. Action Item

a. Film Permit; Starz Heels Production

Jamaal Wallace the production representative indicated that one of the actors tested positive for Covid and will not film on Tuesday, filming could be delayed for 2 weeks.

Councilwoman Howard is requesting that "Street Rental" is on the City Council Meeting Agenda for discussion. Councilwoman Inman expressed a concern that production companies are not providing ample notice to film. Mayor Reynolds suggested tabling discussion for the City Council meeting on Monday, October 5, 2020.

b. Lithonia Cities Week Activities

Councilwoman Inman introduced a T-Mobile representative (Stonecrest Mall) who will be a vendor. A suggestion was made to pair Cities Week with the Farmer's Market. Councilwoman Howard has made arrangements to have the table benches painted in different colors and arranged in the courtyard outside of the city hall annex. Main Street will be closed from Swift to Wiggins Street. Discussions continued.

Councilwoman Inman motioned to waive Vendor Fees for October 10, 2020, the motion was seconded by Councilwoman Howard; and the motion was approved by a vote of 4-0.
